As well, many of your children are training & on their way to swimming varsity, whether here or elsewhere. We know us swimmers are sharp-minded & well-rounded individuals. To keep our swimming community thriving & alive, we need to support our most vulnerable team, the University of Regina Cougars.

There is a new dynasty program the University of Regina has unveiled, called the Green & Gold Community.

The program states:
